



# **IMPORTANTNEWOSHKOSHCAMPINGPOLICY**

**Oshkosh AirVenture 2024** will be here before you know it and it's time to start making plans for this year's **Chapter 5 Campsite.** The last several years have seen the chapter campsite grow in popularity and in the number of units we have managed to squeeze into our assigned space.

Each of the last two years have seen our numbers peak midweek at over 20 campers in as many as 14 units consisting of 2 class C mobile homes, a fifth wheel, a travel trailer, and as many as 10 tents!

With several more chapter members making plans to rent mobile homes or travel trailers for AirVenture 2024, it's time to **make a plan** and set forth a few guidelines in order to make the chapter campsite accessible for all who wish to utilize it.

# UPCOMINGEVENTS IMPORTANTNEWOSHKOSHCAMPINGPOLICY

Here are the guidelines established by the by the Campsite Committee:

1) Only paid Chapter 5 members may reserve a spot for one camping unit at the Chapter 5 campsite. A camping unit is: a motorhome, travel trailer, fifth-wheel, tent, or vehicle. Chapter 5 members may include family members and one non chapter member guest in that one unit. 2) The size of all camping units and vehicles, arrival date/ time, and estimated departure date must be reported to **Tim** or **Sherry Niederkorn** by **June 17th**. This will enable us to begin to create a site plan that allows for smooth arrivals and departures throughout the week. The final plan can't be made until we arrive at Oshkosh and see the layout of our site. The final layout and plan will be sent out to all participants upon Tim & Sherry's arrival the Wednesday before the show begins. Campers who just show up without notification will only be accommodated if the planned space allows.

# UPCOMINGEVENTS IMPORTANTNEWOSHKOSHCAMPINGPOLICY

**3**) Campers must understand the expectations of participating in the chapter campsite. The Chapter 5 campsite as a whole, is a shared space among all participants. No one has rights to any one of the chapter's camping spaces or vehicle credentials, even though your name may appear on it. In the event that space for vehicles becomes full before your arrival, you may have to park your vehicle in the Camp Scholler overflow lot.

**4**) Chapter 5 will front the cost of the campsites. The cost will be divided equitably amongst all campers at the conclusion of Oshkosh. Campers will then reimburse Chapter 5 for their share.

One of the benefits of chapter camping is the ability of chapters from around the country to camp in close proximity allowing for networking and comradery. If you know of members from another chapter that would like to share in our comradery, encourage them to purchase their own chapter campsite(s) and request that they be adjacent to Chapter 5. We would love to share our chapter's goodwill and comradery, but since each chapter is limited to only 6 campsites, we just don't have room for other chapters in our campsite. Finally, we hope to have a great turnout again this year. If you've never been to Oshkosh, make this year your first! **If you've been, but never camped, you're missing half of the experience.**
