



## New flight tracking system at Hinde Field

**Displayed in the EAA Gathering Room** 

What is this flight tracking display all about?

#### From Bob Hemchak

It is simply a real-time presentation of all Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast (ADS-B) Out data being transmitted by aircraft ADS-B transponders. This ADS-B data is received and processed using a locally built and configured tracking station comprised of antennas, software defined radios (SDR), a computer and software designed to parse the ADS-B data for use by several different applications with one being the FlightAware website that many folks are familiar with.

There are two antennas located outside of the Gathering Room. The two antennas are designed to receive ADS-B transmissions on the 1090 MHz extended squitter (1090ES) frequency and 978 MHz universal access transceiver (978 UAT) frequency. These antennas are connected to SDRs that are tuned to receive data on their respective frequencies. The SDRs are [USB] connected to a Raspberry Pi computer. The Raspberry Pi software is primarily used to process these ADS-B returns and send them in batches every 30 seconds to a FlightAware server where they can be

used along with other data to show tracking and flight information on any particular flight.

The Raspberry Pi has software to display the received ADS-B transmissions in real-time (vs. delayed) for all the transmissions received by **THIS** tracking station. ADS-B data is transmitted from the aircraft roughly every second from as far away as 200+ miles. Aircraft on the display are depicted at their current position based on the most recent ADS-B transmission received by the tracking station. Real-time is emphasized here since most web-based applications (e.g. Flightaware.com, FlightRadar24.com, etc.) use data collected by tracking stations such as these to depict the relative position of the aircraft and could be delayed by as much as 30 or more seconds.

## "But I can get all this information on my FlightAware cellphone App."

True. However, this tracking station located at Hinde Field provides a tactical surveillance "hole" or "gap" filler when it comes to aircraft equipped with ADS-B transponders transmitting on the 978 MHz frequency. This is why many of the aircraft based at and/or flying into Hinde Field with 978 MHz transponders never show up in FlightAware as arriving or departing aircraft. But aircraft equipped with 1090ES transponders do show as arrivals and/or departures. Therefore, arriving and departing aircraft statistical data for Hinde Field is somewhat
