Doug Kelly shared the EAA Flight Test Manual for homebuilders that was the result of work that Doug helped start many years ago.

Rex reported that there will be a sheet metal workshop on January 19 and 20. He will, of course, be looking for volunteers to help with setup and running the workshop.

Mark P. shared that he's on his 3rd AGM battery at this point. If anyone would enjoy the benefit of his experience, he has a wealth of knowledge on troubleshooting.

Ernie reported the Cub is coming along well and that there is an open club spot for the Cub. See Ernie or Jerry for details.

Mark G. reported that he applied for our Chapter to receive the Ray Aviation Scholarship for a young aviator. The age range is 16-19 and Dean Stickell will help mentor the recipient.

Mark G. also applied to have Frederick be a tour stop for the Tri-Motor. Unfortunately, the wings on the Tri-Motor are no longer serviceable; there is one company in the U.S. that can make the wings and the cost is around \$1 million. Mark asked the Chapter to consider the possibility of our Chapter making a donation of some sort to help facilitate the rebuild of the wings.

Chapter dues are due in January. They are \$30 again this year.

The 50/50 was \$64 with \$32 each to Mark and to the Scholarship Fund (currently at \$2,129).

Meeting brought to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mark Gosselin

Need a stand-in for the 50/50 to get complete coverage, someone who is outgoing and not afraid to get the money.

Scholarship donor wishes to remain anonymous, but is willing to match \$1,139. Total to \$3,268 when donation is received. Once funds are in the bank, a disbursement needs to be determined. If we get the \$10,000 Ray Aviation Scholarship, we may spend the funds differently than if we weren’t to receive it. Dean has agreed to be the mentor for the scholarship for our Chapter. Need to get to know/interview the kids and determine their level of commitment/enthusiasm and pick a selection process with certain criteria. Students need to participate two hours each month with the Chapter. Anyone involved in the program needs to complete the youth protection program from EAA (can be done online). During interview process, we also need to be sure the parents are supportive.

Project Tin Goose from EAA provides specifications and information regarding funds to repair the Tri-Motor. Looking for Chapters to raise money over a three-year period.

Suggest donating funds from next workshop to Tri-Motor project, but without those funds, the bank account dwindles. We could request to hold more workshops at our location.

Still looking for presenter for March banquet (to be held at the NACC). Erick will take care of securing the NACC for either March 2 or March 9 and make the Chapter aware of any charges.

Chapter renewal from Kyle Volz will be taken care of this weekend.

Meeting adjourned at 7:56 p.m.


