This fall will be exciting with activities and sounds of the airport, including the sound of round engines!



September Program Details

Mark Gosselin gave us a brief flying report at an earlier Chapter meeting on the extended trip he took in his airplane. Doug Kelly felt that it sounded interesting enough that he asked Mark to expand it into a program for our members... and Mark agreed. Following is Doug's description of the program that Mark will present at our September meeting.

"Our intrepid Chapter President will describe this last summer's trip that he and Mary took in their Zodiac. Points covered will include Kitty Hawk and various stops throughout the Southeast, all the way to the tip of the Keys. It ain't quite like it used to be."



August Board Meeting Minutes

Mark Gosselin called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.. Present were: Mark Gosselin, Ernie O'Roark, Doug Kelly, Joe Halleman, and Jack Fromm.

- A motion was made and approved to reimburse Bill Barci \$200 for the Chapter patches he had gotten made.
- Ernie confirmed that Jerry Blake had signed over a check for the balance of the AEC bank account and that the account had been closed.
- Mark circulated a letter he had received from the airport which announced that they were creating an e-mail distribution list of airport tenants to make it easier to keep everyone informed of airport notices and events. We decided to have them add both the President's and the Newsletter Editor's e-mail addresses to the list.
- The e-mail list topic prompted Joe Halleman to suggest that we create a comprehensive procedures document for the Chapter Officers to make it easier to transition new Officers into their roles after they are elected. The suggestion was adopted.
- Jack Fromm had circulated a draft of amended Chapter bylaws for review. The amendments were necessary to bring us into compliance with 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation guidelines for submission to the IRS. Pending a clarification on the requirement to have Chapter members also be members of EAA National, the amendments were adopted unanimously. We are anticipating that the lawyer working on our application will be able to submit the final paperwork to the IRS before the end of the month.
- Doug Kelly said there was not too much new to report on the B-17 visit for the AOPA fly-in on October 4th because the AOPA staff were all out at this weekend's Spokane, Washington event. Doug asked if the Board members who served as committee chairs for the Tri-Motor tour stop would be willing to serve in the same capacities for this event and we all agreed. Doug will let us know when the AOPA folks have returned so we can start coordinating and planning with them.
- Jack Fromm reported that he had looked into free conference call solutions as an alternative way for the Board to meet when the weather is bad or we need to schedule an ad hoc meeting (as we probably will for the B-17 event). We decided to sign up for one of the services.
- Since it was pointed out that the October membership meeting would occur two days before the AOPA fly-in and that the B-17 would probably be here by that time, we thought it might be a good idea to have a program or

speaker related to the bomber. The Board voted to pursue that idea.

- Doug Kelly reminded the Board that he will be resigning his position as Program Coordinator. Mark Gosselin acknowledged that and said he will begin a search for a replacement.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:31.


