## **New Member Benefit—CAD Software**

As I was perusing this month's edition of *Sport Aviation*, I came across an inconspicuous announcement of a new member benefit. "SOLIDWORKS COMPUTER-AIDED DRAFTING software is now available to EAA members as a free member benefit in the form of SolidWorks Student Design Kit — EAA Maker Edition." CAD software can provide some real benefits to builders or restorers but typically the learning curve and purchase price are too steep for the hobbyist. This new offering at least removes the latter hurdle.

If you're interested in learning more about this new benefit, EAA has a <u>SolidWorks Resource Center</u> on its website. There you can find links to the SolidWorks site for dowloading the software and accessing training materials and tutorials. There is also an EAA SolidWorks forum for support.

Although the software is free, it sill requires a pretty robust computer system to run it so you should check out

the system requirements before committing to it. One other caveat is that this free version does not include the Electrical Cable/Harness Design module. That's unfortunate because this would probably be the most useful application for today's homebuilder. However, there were some rumors on the EAA forum that the Dassault folks might be open to including this option in the future.
