December Board Meeting Minutes

14 December 2017

Meeting brought to order at 7:02 pm by Mark Gosselin

Present were Mark Gosselin, Jack Fromm, Rex Bullinger, Ernie O'Roark Doug Kelly, Erick Webb

Mark G. for Mark P. proposes we do the same for the banquet that we've done the past 2 years by approaching Mike Woods for using the space for March 3 or March 10 and using Canapés for catering and shooting for \$50/person mark and BYOB. Richard McSpadden will potentially be the speaker. The Chapter will cover costs for Mike Woods and spouse, and Richard McSpadden and spouse.

Ernie emailed the donor that the current scholarship fund is \$661 and he will send a check for \$661. \$1,322 will be the total scholarship fund.

Doug said a number of years ago, a donor was interested in creating a memorial scholarship, so a committee was formed (3 members) and they solicited applications through the flight school of young people (criteria were provided for dates, timelines, ages, etc.) and there were around a dozen applications to choose from initially. It was agreed that the committee should be composed of Chapter members and not include board members.

Have the board make suggestions to the committee and let them decide. Whoever applies needs to actively pursue some form of education in the field of aviation (going to a camp at AirVenture, ground school, flight training, etc). Would submit a letter explaining why they should receive the scholarship, and how they'd use it. Once awarded, how do we get confirmation that they did it? Once they've used the scholarship, it would be preferred to have them come back and report on it, or write a letter, etc.

New format for Chapter meetings seemed to work well.

January meeting program will be held at the MD State Police hangar. Meet at Chapter house at 7, meet for about 20 minutes, then all go to the MSP Hangar to be there at 7:30.

Five or six letters have come in for Bingelis award. Mark G. got newsletters for workshops from Doug regarding history of Jerry's involvement. Every model of RV except RV-10.

Name tags. Good idea to get tags from national and print/stick for new members. Perhaps quarterly we could get the more official name tags. Will do an order for new members in January and allow current members to chip in for the cost of a new tag for themselves if they want another.
