AOPA Fly-In May 10-11, 2019; Mark G shared that we had good volunteer coverage for the Saturday morning first shift at the AOPA pancake breakfast but we were still a bit short for Saturday second shift and for the Friday shifts.

Workshops: Rex learned that we may have two more workshops scheduled for this year, Electrical and Sheet Metal. He has contacted Mark Forss to determine the dates.

Tri-Motor restoration: the chapter has received \$550 in donations dedicated for that project. A chapter member has promised to make up to difference so that our chapter can submit a total of \$1,000 for the project.
