MINNESOTA SPORT AVIATION CONFERENCE

An all-day conference, devoted to sport aviation, will be held this Saturday at the Thunderbird Hotel in Bloomington. The conference's stated purpose is to, "provide a medium for expanding technical knowledge within this avocation (sport aviation), and otherwise promote operational safety."

The Minnesota Department of Transportation, Office of Aeronautics, is sponsoring this event, in conjunction with the Minnesota Experimental Aircraft Association, Minnesota Ultralight Association, Balloon Pilots Association, and (new to the event this year) the Soaring Society of America.

Topics covered during the morning sessions will be devoted to areas of interest specific to the four cosponsoring organizations. The agenda for EAA members includes, Construction and Certification; Engine Maintenance; Test Flying; EAA Perspective.

General Session topics in the afternoon include, Low Altitude Weather; Airspace and TCA/Mode C Update; Drug Awareness.

Registration begins at 7:15 am, the conference at 8:00 am the morning of February 10th. The fee at the door is \$15.00 and includes lunch and coffee breaks. I attended this event last year and found it to be well-run, informative, and worthwhile.

MINNESOTA AVIATION HALL OF FAME

The inaugural induction ceremony for the Minnesota Aviation Hall of Fame will be held at the Saturday night banquet dinner during the State Aviation Symposium, April 7th. Thirteen pioneer Minnesota aviators, selected by a committee of Minnesota aviation historians, will be enshrined in the Hall of Fame with award plaques.

Sherm Booen will be master of ceremonies for this charter induction. Many family members of the inductees have been invited and will be introduced during the ceremony.

The Minnesota Aviation Hall of Fame is a chapter of the National Aviation Hall of Fame, located at Dayton, Ohio. The Minnesota chapter was chartered by the Minnesota Department of Transportation, Aeronautics Division, and will be sponsored each year by different private corporations. This year's sponsor is Scanlan International of St. Faul.
