'86 EAA CONVENTION HIGHLIGHTS: Convention Chairman Tom Poberezny said that this year's convention was characterized by a variety of activities and the comaraderic of participants. "The overwhelming sentiment of the people attending this year's event was that we were able to offer programs and activities that appealed to aviation interest Instead of one focal point, we had something going on all over the convention site. This variety helped make Oshkosh '86 the most successful ever."

Some impressive statistics emerged from the convention including an estimated 15,000 transient aircraft; 1,741 registered show planes; 1,424 visitors from 66 different foreign countries; and a record 938 members of the int'l press corps who reported on the celebrations of flight. The FAA recorded 64,348 aircraft movements during the week.

The GOODYEAR BLIMP glided gracefully through the skies over Oshkosh throughout the convention. Its evening flights were enhanced by a spectacular light show. The Italian military aerobatice jet team, "Frecce Tricolori" conducted beautiful and precise demonstrations on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. The team's solo pilot is a long-time EAA member and amateur aircarft builder. If you missed their performance, the cover of the next issue of SPORT AVIATION will give you some idea of the artistry of the team.
