The meeting was called to order at 7:00 by President Larry McClure immediately followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Larry McClure

- New member Sonny Thurman and his dog were introduced to the membership.
- Reminder, we have Saturday morning coffee at the facility each Saturday from 8:00 until about 10:00.
- March's Pancake Breakfast was very successful.

Dick Solar - Takeoffs

- Recommend immediately prior to taking the runway that you double check fuel on, mixture rich, trim set, and winds
- Be prepared for left turning tendencies produced by torque, spiraling slipstream, and P-factor.
- A good T/O speed for many aircraft is VY.
- FAA recommends not turning crosswind until 700' agl so you can be at pattern altitude by downwind.
- Takeoffs are optional. Landings are mandatory.
