Launched in 1992, the Young Eagles program has dedicated more than 25 years to giving youth ages 8–17 their first free flight in an airplane. The only program of its kind, its sole mission is to introduce and inspire kids in the world of aviation. These flights are made possible through the generosity of EAA member volunteers.

The Manitoba Chapter 63 will be awarding the opportunity for one Manitoba female youth, age 16-18, to attend the Advanced Air Academy Camp in Oshkosh, WI, July 19 – 27, 2022. Our chapter will cover tuition costs, but the recipient will be required to provide transportation. Below are some links that provide further details.

The EAA Advanced Air Academy provides an atmosphere for mature students to become totally immersed in the world of flight. Ground instruction and introductory recreation flight experiences highlight this meaningful, action-packed camp. It combines "in-the-air" and "on-the-ground" hands-on activities.

The EAA Advanced Air Academy includes full participation (access to forums, flightline and all associated activities) in EAA AirVenture Oshkosh, the world's premier aviation event! Ground school topics include: fundamentals of flight science, aircraft systems, aircraft preflight, flight controls and systems, weather, aerial navigation, flight training requirements. aircraft construction, restoration and maintenance skills: welding, sheet metal work, composite fabrication, aeromodeling and woodworking. Youth also learn about aviation history and flight, tour the EAA AirVenture Museum, fly EAA's flight simulators, visit Pioneer Airport, experience the thrill of flight in both an airplane and helicopter.
