FEES: Weekly \$12.00 per person 3.00

Children (under 14) . . Free WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY A REGISTERED ADULT.

- 1. This fee entitles ONLY QUALIFIED AVIATION VISITORS (including their immediate family) to Fly-in privileges.
- 2. Fly-in Privileges may be purchased by:
 - a. Guests of Qualified Aviation Visitors (other than immediate family)
 - b. Bonafide aviation organization members, and their guests. presenting valid membership cards in EAA, AAA, AOPA, etc.
 - c. Pilots or individuals holding and presenting a valid Airman's Certificate of any type.
- 3. Children (under 14) will not be permitted on flight line without a registered adult.
- No Pets are allowed anywhere on the Fly-in site including Campgrounds.

CAMPGROUND -- For Qualified Aviation Visitors.

FEE: Daily . . . In Advance . . . \$ 4.00 per Unit,

starting the day Unit is parked (or set up) through last day of Fly-in. CHECK-OUT TIME . . 12:00 noon. Units leaving later will be charged another day. REFUNDS of \$4.00 per day will be made at the CAMPGROUND REGISTRATION BUILDING when: Packed vehicle/camper appears at Registration Building, & Campsite Tenant credentials are surrendered.


- 1. All units must have proper identification to remain in Campgrounds.
