### YRA Board News

With the seal coat project completed, the next step in runway and taxiway maintenance is scheduled for some time between Aug 21 and Sep 2. All the pavement markings will be repainted requiring runway closure. Watch the NOTAMs for specific dates and times.

Construction of the T-hangars was to begin July 24. Each complex will include 11 T-hangars and a restroom at the end. Completion is expected by April 2024. With CARES Act funding short for completion of both sets of hangars, one set will definitely be heated. It is possible that the other will not be heated. If you are interested in renting one of the new hangars, Aaron Buck, Airport Director, is taking names of interested parties, so you are encouraged to get your name on the list. Aaron is expecting rental rates for the heated hangars to be in the range of \$400-480 per month and \$300-380 for those without heat. There are 11 interested parties on the list, so half may already be spoken for. Don't delay if interested. The color was chosen at the July Board meeting. They will be tan with red trim, matching the ARFF (Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting) building on the southeast side of the field.
