# YOUR RAFFLE TICKET COULD WIN THIS NEW RANS S-19 VENTERRA AIRCRAFT



In 2018, a nearly completed RANS S-19 was offered to EAA Chapter 72 as a gift. After we got over the shock and pleasure of this gift, we determined the best use of this extremely well built aircraft would be to raffle the aircraft off. The proceeds of this raffle will be dedicated to scholarships for pilot and mechanic training. In addition, our Chapter will acquire a flight simulator for the region's pilots to use to maintain currency and advanced training.

In the interim, we have completed the aircraft with only final paint to be applied in June 2022.



Over \$100,000 invested in the totally new 2022 RANS S-19 E-AB. Equipped with a factory new Rotax 912-ULS, with a Sensenich composite ground adjustable propeller. The Dynon Avionics package include: Two D700 displays, EMS-220 engine monitoring module, ADHRS primary and secondary, roll and pitch servos, AOA/pitot probe, backup battery, Mode-S transponder, GPS-2020 ADS-B OUT and the comm is a Garmin SL40.

Instructions for entering the Academy, along with directions to the cemetery, follow.

Visitor Access to the Academy:

From Interstate-25 take Exit 156 (North Gate). This entrance is open to visitors from 5:30 am to 10:00 pm every day. When entering the gate, present a valid form of photo identification such as driver's license or passport. Expired IDs will not be accepted. Children under the age of 10 do not require identification. You may be asked to share additional information such as proof of insurance and vehicle registration. If applicable, have your car rental agreement handy. All vehicles are subject to inspection by security personnel, so they may ask you to pop your trunk. Firearms are not permitted on Academy grounds. For additional help accessing the base, contact Security Forces at 719-333-2000.

Directions to the United States Air Force Academy Cemetery:

Approximately 1 mile after entering the North Gate, turn left onto Stadium Blvd. Take the next Right onto Parade Loop. The cemetery is on the right, just before Golf Loop.
