It was completed almost a year ago, but he was delayed in finding an available hangar at KFLY. With the help of his sons, Dean and Eric, the airplane was disassembled enough to get it through the big basement window and onto a trailer to bring it to the airport. It only took a few days to get it ready for certification and it flew the very next day on July 20, 2022. Dean and Eric will do the test flying while 93-year-old Ken goes back to work, building the RV-14 kit that recently arrived at his home. Never stop building!


