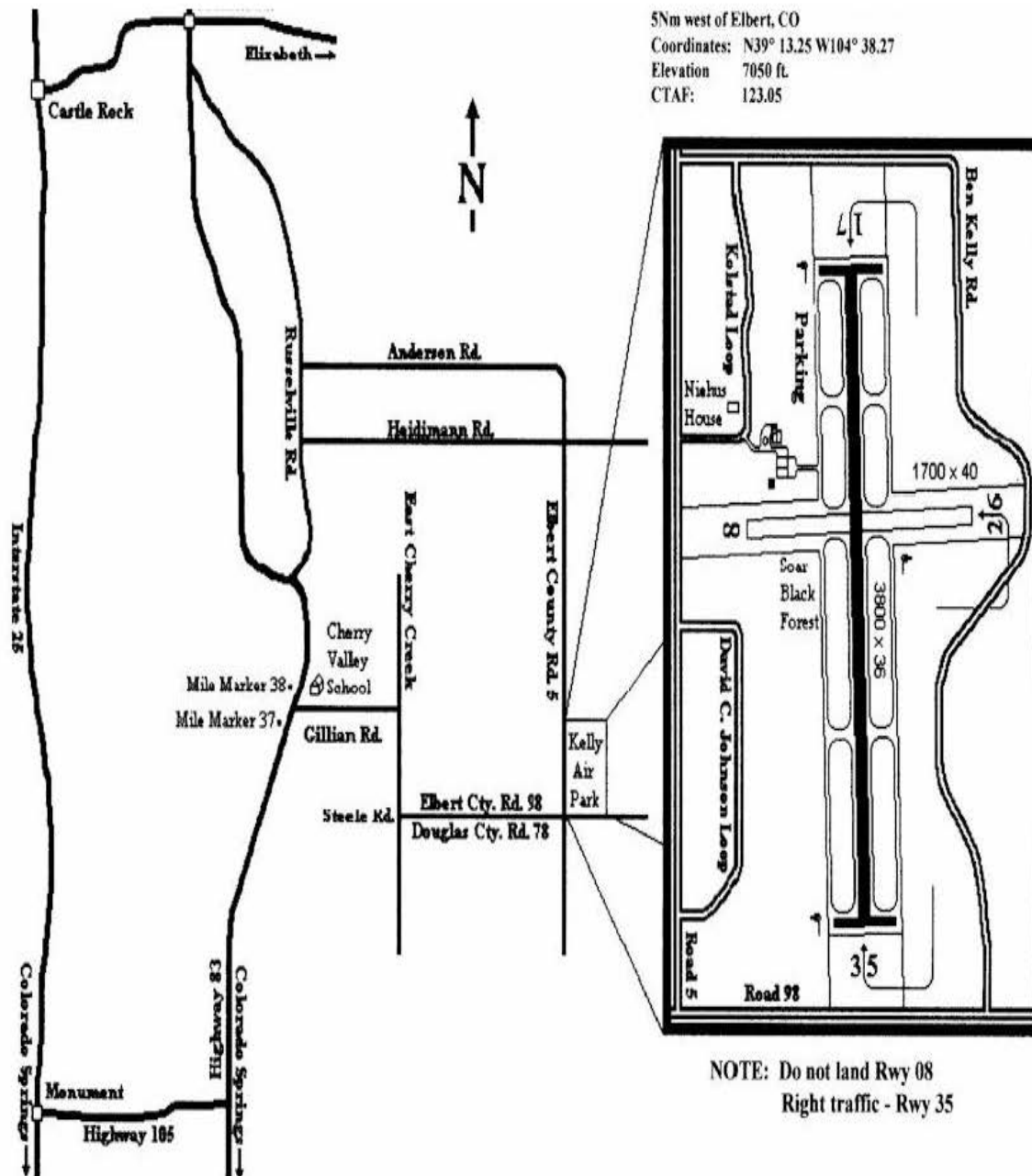

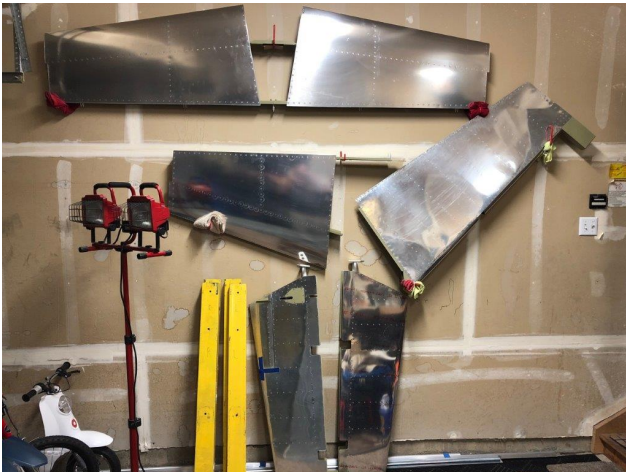


I have a completed empennage kit (minus glass) and a started wing kit (just countersunk spar). I am also selling the tools with the kit for an additional cost.
