



Fred's Father's Day Surprise

My wife and daughters surprised me with a seaplane ride for Fathers Day last month. We were on vacation to Destin, FL and there was a small seaplane flying up and down the beach we were staying at. This happened on the first day we arrived and went down to the beach. The next day I was surprised to get a text saying I had been gifted a seaplane ride. Wow, what a Fathers Day gift for a pilot. The seaplane was SeaRay amphibian with a pusher Rotax engine. The operator I flew with owned three of these, gave rides and provided instruction to get your seaplane rating.

In order to board the plane you had to wade out to it in 3' of water, so I was wet from the waist down. The take off was interesting because of all the boats using the same inlet we were using made for very choppy water. We finally got up on the step and lifted off. The ride lasted 27 minutes and consisted of going up and down several beaches at 500-700 ft AGL. We saw schools of tarpon, a large school of sharks just outside one of the inlets and several old pier structures only visible from the air. I was able to get my hands on the controls for a few minutes and actually got a sticker showing 0.3 hours of seaplane instruction. The landing was smoother than the takeoff and I enjoyed the ride very much.
