EAA Chapter 766 Aviation Scholarship

Criteria and Requirements

SCHOLARSHIPS

Funds Distribution

- Scholarship(s) will be awarded each year when funds are available.
- The scholarship funds may be used to defray aviation related expenses at any school with an FAA certified program.
- Funds will be forwarded directly to the recipient.

Eligibility Requirements

- The applicant must be a student in a Sheboygan County School District.
- He/She must be a student preparing for an aviation-oriented career.

Documents to Be Submitted

- A completed application form must be submitted.
- Two (2) recommendations must be submitted with the application. One (1) of the recommendations must be from an academic source such as a teacher.
- A copy of the most recent grade transcript must also be submitted.

NOTIFICATION AND DISBURSEMENTS OF SCHOLARSHIPS

- The recipient will be notified of the award by letter and telephone as soon as possible after the award has been authorized by the Board of Directors
- It will be the responsibility of the recipient to notify the selection committee upon successful completion of the first semester or other agreed upon milestone. Provide a copy of the first semester grades (or other acceptable documentation) to the selection committee.
- A check will be mailed to the recipient upon successful completion of the first semester or other agreed upon milestone.
