

The airstrip is open barring a significant snowfall, but even if we were to have some snow, Lake Lawn is within reasonable driving distance, so our Plan B is to drive there. If you fly-in it is about a five minute walk to the Frontier Restaurant, but a call to the Lodge - 262-728-7950 - will get you a ride there. On Sunday they feature a Champagne Brunch normally priced at \$26.95, but a call to the Manager yielded an offer for a 20% discount without the champagne. The identifier is C59, runway is 18/36 with 4423' x 80' asphalt, and a track of about 340° for 28 NM will get you there from 3CK. There are no services provided.
