#### FALL 2021 CHAPTER FUNDRAISING EVENT

A chapter committee had been studying and proposing a fall pork chop dinner event. At our July meeting, Mike Wiskus (chapter member and owner of West Metro Aviation) described his proposal to develop and host a "Swap Meet" at the Buffalo Airport. He is proposing, and will coordinate, a Swap Meet for aviation items (clean out your hangars!) which would also include the option to bring in aircraft for display/sale. Mike envisioned one or two large tents erected on the Buffalo Airport grounds, with table space for rent by vendors.

The original committee, composed of Greg Thomes, Laura Herrmann, Henry Williams, and Boyd Emmel was joined by Wayne Flury and Mike Wiskus in a planning meeting earlier this month.

Laura has a flyer developed and publicity will begin shortly. Everything, of course, is contingent upon continuing maintenance or improvement in the COVID-19 situation.

The current plan is for the Swap Meet to be held on Saturday and Sunday, October 17 & 18 (set up on Friday afternoon) from 8 AM to 3 PM both days, with an air show by Mike at 2 PM each day (and he hopes to conscript some additional performers!).

The chapter will serve a Pork Chop Lunch on Saturday from 11 AM to 2 PM, and a Pancake Breakfast on Sunday from 8 AM to 12 noon.

Mike is very excited about the potential for a Swap Meet, both for this year and the future. The chapter will serve in the West Metro hangar, and proceeds benefit the chapter.

There are still some issues to be worked out with Mike about insurance for the air show, and Chapter 878's involvement.

This weekend event will require maximum participation by the members of Chapter 878, but the potential as a fund raiser is high. The attraction of the Swap Meet and Air Show should be a good draw, not only for pilots across Minnesota, but also the general public.

#### CHAPTER 878 HANGAR UPDATE

The chapter hangar committee is looking into building or buying a hangar for the chapter. In a concurrent City of Maple Lake airport study, various options for opening up new hangar building sites is being looked at. Primary area is the grass covered field behind our current hangar (C-5) and the original Wright Aero hangar. Airport study is still underway.

Electrical service to Hangar C-5 has been completed, and the chapter has had discussion about getting this hangar ready for possible use this winter (rent space for airplane storage?).

A chapter work day for this purpose is still yet to be scheduled.
