FAA Offers ADS-B Rebate

Starting this Fall, the FAA is offering a monetary incentive to help owners of general aviation equip with the required avionics that comply with the ADS-B Out rule that will take effect Jan 1, 2020. The agency will offer a \$500 rebate to eligible aircraft owners. To be eligible, your aircraft must be a fixed-wing, single-engine piston aircraft that is U.S.-registered and not currently equipped with Version 2 ADS-B Out. PLEASE READ IF Camping With Chapter 95 at AirVenture Oshkosh 2016 (Or thinking about camping with us)

It's hard to believe it is time to start planning our campsite for Oshkosh. We have to do things a little different this year, so PLEASE read this article, even if you have camped with us before and think you know the drill.

First, for those of you that have never camped with us before and are interested in joining us. EAA Chapter 95 members (family and friends) camp in an area together for the week at Camp Scholler. We bring the big chapter canopy (last year Tom Ellis brought even a bigger event tent), along with the chapter grill and tables. Everyone is welcome to use the grill anytime, morning, noon, and night.

Matt and Jana go up to Oshkosh the Wednesday before the show starts (July 20th) and buy the campsites and rope off the area for Chapter 95. The only way to guarantee a spot in this area is if you pay in advance. AirVenture requires us to buy the campsites from the time we arrive until the end of the show. If you leave early, you get a refund, except for the 3 night minimum. Please note the cost for camping went up \$1 again this year. The cost of each campsite is \$27 a night and we are reserving the spots for 12 nights, so that comes to \$324 for each campsite you would like saved.

This is where things change from previous years. We can no longer leave your credentials at the front gate for you to pick up. We have had a few people volunteer to fly up on Wednesday and pick up everyone's credentials and bring

them back to Morris for you to pick up there before you leave for Oshkosh.

If you plan to camp with us this year, PLEASE send me an e-mail (jana.trof@gmail.com) ASAP to let us know you are camping with us and what day you plan to arrive in Oshkosh. We need this information BEFORE the ice-cream social in July so that we can start coordinating the plan to get the credentials ahead of time and work out the logistics. We will explain the plan at the ice-cream social in July.

If you are one of the people that have volunteered to fly up to Oshkosh and pick up the camping credentials, please contact Matt before the ice-cream social so we can make solid plans.

If you are camping with us, please come to the ice-cream social (July 15) and give us your camping fee (\$324, check or cash), your EAA number, what day you plan to arrive and depart, and what kind/size camper or tent you have. The last few years people have just found me (or I've found you) at the ice-cream social to collect your money, however this year we need to get everyone together and have a brief meeting about the new procedure. Please plan to meet in Matt and Jana's hanger at 6:30pm for a brief meeting to sync up on the plans. If you cannot make it to the ice-cream social, please contact Matt and Jana as soon as possible PRIOR to the ice-cream social.

Kankakee Young Eagles Day

Chapter 95 was requested by the Greater Kankakee
Airport to run their Young Eagles Rally on May 21,
2016 in conjunction with their Fly-In and Car Show,
as well as few other activities including their "Pause
for Patriotism". The published plan was for it to run from 8
a.m. to Noon.

There is no pre-registration for their Young Eagles. It is on a first come, first served basis. This proved very interesting since we had to stop registration at 9:30 a.m. because we had 57 Young Eagles signed up already. Of the 57, 28 of them were Boy Scouts from 3 different troops. There were only 8 pilots flying. Of these, 4 pilots flew slower planes like a Stearman and a Piper Cub, but fortunately we had 3 pilots who could handle 3 Young Eagles at a time.

We also had a Waiting List Signup for those who wanted to really fly and were not a part of the original 57. Most of these people came back around 11 o'clock and pleaded to have their kids fly. In the end we flew 98 Young Eagles finishing the last flight at 1:30 p.m.

Our pilots did a great job, both our Chapter 95 pilots and a few non-members who agreed for our Chapter to receive credit for the kids flown. Thanks to our Chapter pilots: Brian DePung (flew 19 kids), Matt Kwiatkowski (flew 4 kids), Mark Molle (flew 10 kids), and Warren Roddy (who flew Young Eagles for the first time, flew 4 kids). Also thanks to our non-member pilots: Chuck Bohlmann (flew 2 kids), Don Rothermel (flew 22 kids), Steve Russell (flew 33 kids), and Hershel Wix (flew 4 kids).

The Kankakee airport process is a little different than our Chapter's. They don't take photos (thank goodness). There is no way that we could have handled that at this airport. Fortunately the Office Manager (Pamela Rose) and the Airport Manager (Victoria Ruble) loaned us a few of their staff in order to get the paperwork done. It really was an interesting process, but long and tiring.




