Chapter Business

The March meeting was held at the chapter's new meeting location, the Oakland Air facility at PTK. Roger Bentlage, President of IAC Chapter 134 (and still a member of Chapter 88) flew in with his RV from Marquette to joint us at the March meeting. Roger was accompanied by Kai Carter, student pilot and aerobatic aspirant. Kim Fanelli, our newest chapter member, was accompanied by Frances Rose. Kim and Frances are members of the Ninety-Nines, Intern. Organization of Women Pilots.

Most of the meeting discussion focused on the preparations for the Michigan Open competition:

Hotel: group rate has been secured and has been posted on the IAC contest calendar

Sponsors: 2 more sponsors have signed up, making it a total of 8.

Contest Insurance: in the process of setting up a meeting with the Bay City Pub. Works Director. Objective, getting hazard classification of contest lowered from high to medium, resulting in a lower insurance amount. 3CM A/P Manager, Jeff Koons, is happy to advocate our request.

Pre-Registration: document requirements have been defined and posted on IAC Contest Calendar, see below

Contest Entry Fee: same as 2019, will include hangar fee and 1 ticket for the Saturday night banquet – Primary \$120, Sportsman through Unlimited \$135.

Contest Insurance

The chapter is preparing for a meeting with Bay City officials to review its special event hazard category classification.

In parallel, the chapter is working with IAC corporate to review the current contest insurance options.

Chapter 88 Documents

Sandy was able to retrieve a number of cartons containing past year's chapter documents. Hugo took possession of them and agreed to sort through them to inventory their content.

The following document was archived in one of those cartons. It is a brief history of IAC Chapter 88, listing the people instrumental in getting Chapter 88 started and going during those early years of organized aerobatic flying.





May 14, 1980

A BRIEF HISTORY OF TAC CHAPTER 88

S.E. Michigan Chapter 88, I.A.C., was formed when a group of national I.A.C. members and interested people began to meet in the E.A.A. Chapter 113 hangar at Mettetal Airport, Plymouth, Michigan in 1973. George Lytle was the first President.

In the early years the Chapter held a series of flying meetings at various local airports in order to gain publicity and new members. These affairs for a couple of years took the form of "Corn Roasts", with some aero demonstrations. We then offered aero instruction in 15 and 30 minute segments at the meetings in a further attempt at reaching interested parties. This endeavor was soon abandoned as it was highly unproductive and was very wearing on Dave McKenzie who spent many hours giving instruction, 15-30 minutes at a time, to what turned out to be casually interested people who were never seen again.

1977 — Labogony in 1978

In 1975 we obtained a waiver for a permanent practice area. By 1978 we were able to hold a 3 category contest at Milan, Michigan. This grew to a successful 4 category contest in 1979, which will be repeated in 1980.

GEORGE LYTLE

EDITORS NOTE: The chapter was incorporated in Mich Nov 17, 1973. However, several sources indicate get together meetings were being held in 1972. George says this is quite possable. The first contest was promoted and organized by Dave McKenzie in 1977 rather than 1978 and held at Milan, Mich. The original officers were: G. Lytle-Pres., Bill Unger, Jay Cavender, Jim Hazlett, & Bob Barns. George Lytle served a second term as pres. in 1974. Then his presidency was followed by: Bill Unger, D. Houdek, H. Harris, D. McDonald, & A. Patstone, our current president.
