Invasion Stripes



There is an Avid Flyer Mod C+ located in hangar #26 in Merrill related to a War Bird L-16, located at Circle K in Irma. The relationship is in stripe only, invasion stripes. The builder of the Avid Flyer, early on, saw a similarity to the L-16 and thought it was a



cool look. This builder didn't dig very deep, but that is another story.

At AirVenture, you can't miss this same paint scheme on many War Birds representing the D-day assault, June 1944. What was the function of the two alternating black and white stripes? Yup, painting top and bottom surfaces of the wings of aircraft supporting the Normandy Invasion helped indentify allied Friendlies in flight.

Transponder signal identification was available at the time of the invasion but, because of the overwhelming number of aircraft, not all airplanes could be equipped. Black and white stripes proved to be most practical.

You Go Girl

Robina Asti, a 99- year-old woman, broke two Guinness records as the oldest active pilot and flight instructor. She gave her final flight lesson on a recent Sunday at Riverside Municipal airport, CA.
