By the time he came home from school that afternoon, the plane was gone. His aviation hunger was primary to his formal education. By his junior year in high school, he was selling rides on his solo flying permit, in the American Eagle his father helped him purchase, as well as flying an unlicensed homebuilt plane on its maiden flight in Milwaukee County, which was illegal, and cost him his solo permit. Through it all, he credits all the teachers that recognized and helped him funnel his obsession by assisting him in achieving his dreams, and graduating from high school. EAA Deal
