

- Airworthiness Inspection like the airplane's birth certificate.
- Weight and Balance.
- o Operating Limitations.
- Pilot Operations Handbook (POH).

The pilot needs to be carrying:

- Their certificate or license.
- Photo ID because there is no picture on the pilot certificate. This can be a Wis-

consin driver's license or ID, Military ID, Passport.

 Medical certificate - if not under Sport Pilot licensing.
