Steve reviewed winter flying tips he read about in Plane and Pilot:

Dress for the environment, preheat your engine according to the manufacturer. If you have heated it, it should be flown. Wrap the engine cowling when heating, if you are parked outside make sure to have good wing covers. Have a winterization kit on board. This should include survival gear and a beacon. Are you night current and have you been checked for night flying? Make sure to do a complete pre-flight inspection. Check your wheel fairings to make sure that water and slush are not building up. A CO2 detector is good to have. Watch snow and ice conditions if you are hand propping.

Lastly, tell someone where you are going and let them know when you get there.

-John Szigat reported that the upholsterer was impressed with his panel measurements for his Dakota Hawk.

-Brian Krueger told us about being a pilot on an American Airlines 787. Pretty amazing stuff to hear about.
