## My Sixth Month with the Ray Aviation Scholarship



This month I did lots of flying! Starting with Thursday March 30, I completed my dual cross country to Chico with Stan. On Tuesday April 4, I went on a night flight with Tyler to KDWA 

O08—KMYV—KLHM— KMCC— KSAC— KEDU. On Saturday April 8, I did my first solo (almost) cross country to Nut Tree, Yolo, Davis, Franklin, and Executive. However, when doing my landings at Nut Tree, I noticed my fuel was low and made a quick stop at KEDU to get fuel before going on to Yolo. At the fuel pump, a fellow pilot offered to pump my fuel so as to "not ruin my pretty nails," sweet but funny!
