As 14 CFR 91.225 states, "After Jan 1, 2020...", Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast (ADS-B) "Out" became mandatory for rule airspace. To follow up on last year's programs which discussed this rule and the optional ADS-B In capabilities, I will recap the mandate and provide some insight to how things are going now that its here. 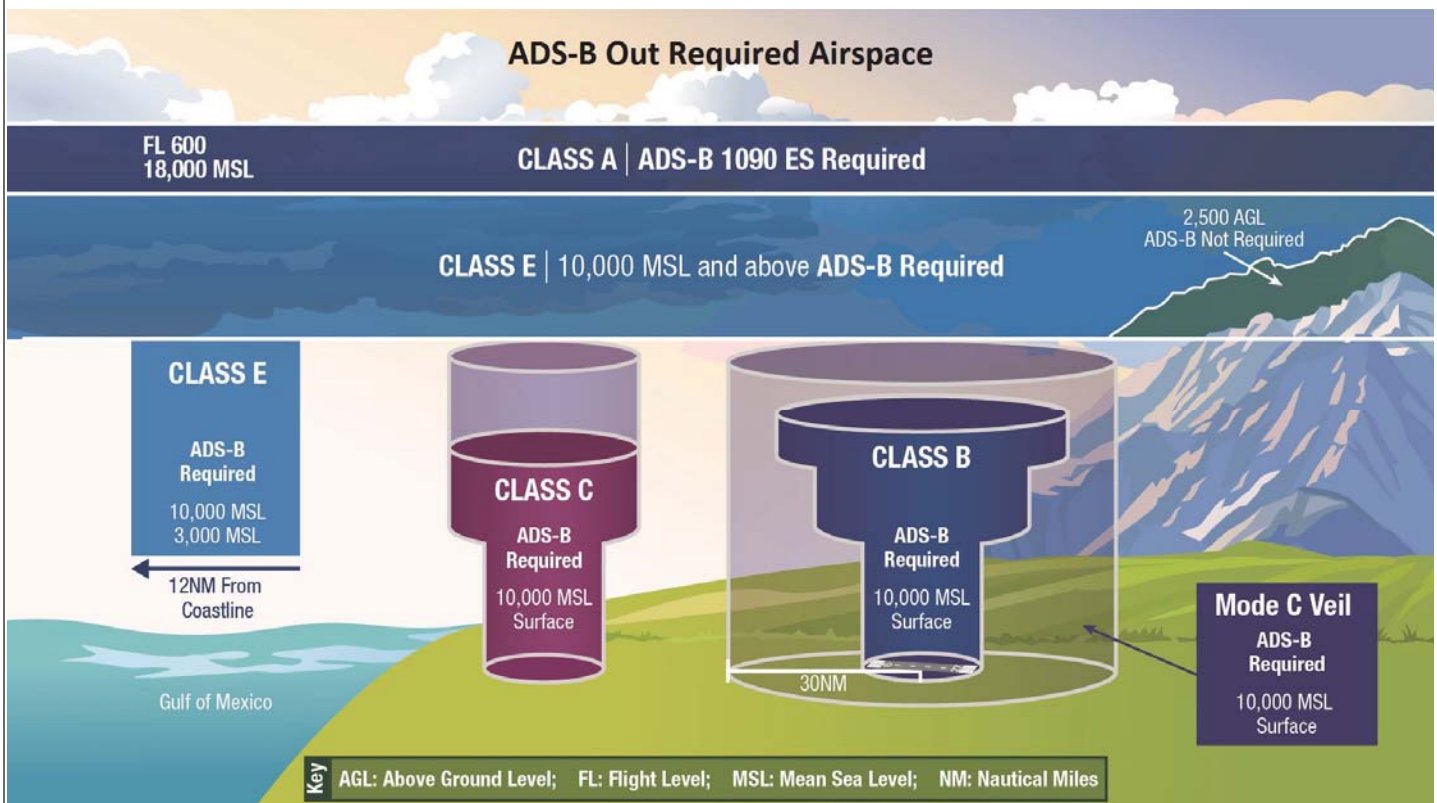

## Lesser Known Celebrity Pilots

Ok, we all know those celebrity pilots who participate and advocate for aviation; John Travolta, Harrison Ford, Tom Cruise, etc., but who are those lesser known celebrity pilots that we don't typically hear about? Here's a good list...

### Angelina Jolie and Brad Pitt

Angelina obtained her Private Pilot Certificate in 2004 and bought a Cirrus SR22 in 2005. She was inspired by her adopted son's love of airplanes, who is now taking lessons himself. She is said to have let her aircraft registration expire and was caught by the FAA while still operating the privilege. She also owns a Cessna 208 Grand Caravan.

Her then-husband, Brad Pitt, also got his certificate in their SR22. Now he flies his own WWII Spitfire after training at the Boulton Flight Academy in Oxford.



### Morgan Freeman

Although he joined the Air Force as a mechanic, Morgan Freeman didn't learn to fly until he was 65 years old. Freeman owns a Cessna 414 and a Citation 501. The actor has also loaned his recognizable voice to marketing materials for the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association.

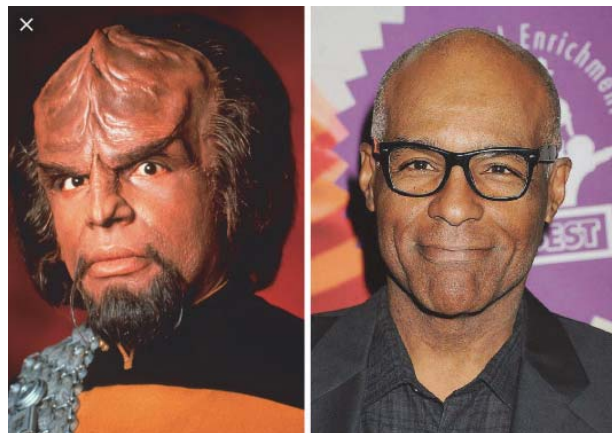


### Jimmy Buffett

Musician and singer Jimmy Buffet may sing about Margaritaville, but how do you think he gets there? He flies himself, of course! Buffett has stated that he's wanted to fly since college, but couldn't afford it until his breakout success in the 70s and 80s. He's come a long way since then, and is now the proud owner of six airplanes, including a Cessna 208 Caravan, Boeing E75 Stearman and Falcon 900.

### Michael Dorn

Star Trek actor Michael Dorn may command a spaceship in a movie, but in real life, he's an avid pilot of airplanes. During the Deep Space Nine series, Dorn went from pretend starship lieutenant to actual airplane pilot who has flown with the Blue Angels and Thunderbirds. In addition, he's on the Air Force Heritage Foundation's advisory board. He has owned an Aerospatiale-Socata Trinidad TB-20, a Cessna 310 and 340, a T-33, MU-2, F-86 Sabre, North American Sabreliner and a Beech Baron.



### Dr Phil (McGraw)

Phil McGraw, host of the popular daytime talk show Dr. Phil, may be known for his psychological and relationship advice, but he's also licensed to fly private single-engine airplanes and has an instrument rating. He's been navigating the skies long before he became a household name, being a certified pilot since 1976. He's also an Okie, born right here in Vinita, OK.

### Tim McGraw

The country music singer and actor is also a Cirrus owner. Tim loves flying himself for both

work and personal trips. His wife Faith has been supportive and was involved in his decision to buy into the safety of the Cirrus as well as customizing the interior.

### Ken Griffey, Jr

Baseball legend Ken Griffey Jr. may be an accomplished athlete, with 13 Major League Baseball All-Star titles, but did you know that he's also an accomplished pilot? Not only is Griffey an official Cirrus pilot, he has been named an honorary co-chair of the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association (AOPA) Foundation's Hat in the Ring Society. According to the AOPA, the foundation is "a committed group of pilots who support the work of the AOPA Foundation's mission to promote aviation safety and education and to protect the freedom to fly." His father was a pilot and took Ken for his first flight at age 13. Ken started flight training at the age of 36 and has owned a Cirrus SR22T and the SF50 Vision Jet.



### Phil Mickelson

When golfer Phil Mickelson goes to his tournaments, he rides in style, flying a Gulfstream V valued at around \$40 million. So what made this golf legend decide to spend his time learning to fly? Apparently, his father was a former Navy and airline pilot, prompting Mickelson's initial interest in the world of aviation.



### Alan Jackson

Another country music star to make the list is Alan Jackson. While flying to and from gigs, Jackson learned how to fly by watching and learning from the pilot. He expands on this point in a post on his website, stating, "When I started flying to work, I got interested in watching the pilot who flew me and he taught me. At that time, we had a farm with a pretty big grass strip and I had a plane with amphibious gear, so I could land on water, the lake. I just kind of flew around Nashville. I still have my license, I just don't fly. Denise (Jackson's wife) got tired of my flying and worrying about me."

### Kurt Russell

Kurt Russell says flying runs in the blood, as his grandfather had one of the first float planes in Maine. "The love of airplane for pilots, I think, is almost inexplicable. It's the experience itself. It's the fact that you can't explain it, I think, that makes you feel the way you do about it. This is something that can change your life," he told one interviewer. He is, in fact, the pilot who first reported the Phoenix Lights phenomenon. Every UFO obsessive knows about the Phoenix Lights, a mass sighting that took place in 1997, which has since become one of the best-known UFO incidents.

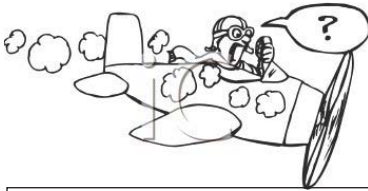
