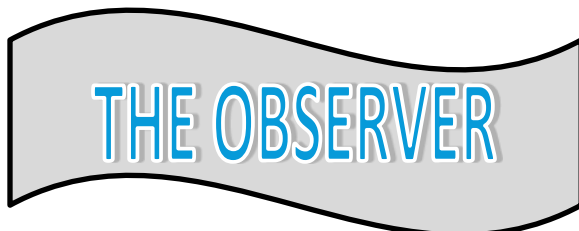

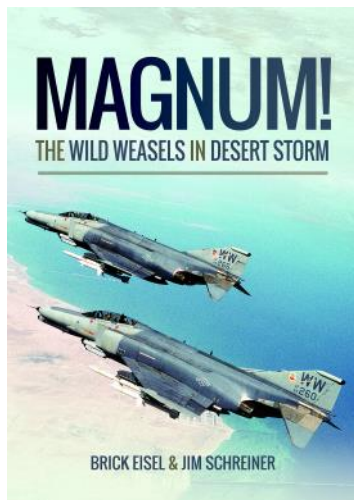

Book Review



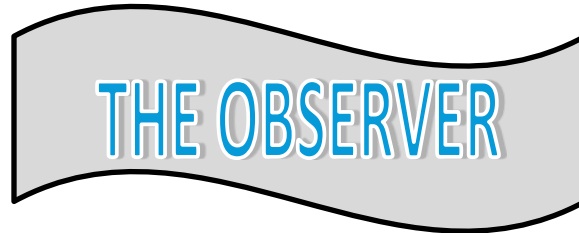
Magnum! The Wild Weasels in Desert Storm: The Elimination of Iraq's Air Defence

by Braxton R Eisel (Author), James A Schreiner (Author)

This book is based on a journal Jim Schreiner kept during his deployment to the Persian Gulf region for Operations DESERT SHIELD and DESERT STORM. Building upon that record and the recollections of other F-4G Wild Weasel aircrew, the authors show a slice of what life and war were like during that time. The pawns in the game, the ones that had to actually do the fighting and dying, were the hundreds of thousands of men and women who left their homes and families to live for seemingly endless months in the vast, trackless desert while the world stage-play unfolded. To them, the war was deeply personal. At times, the war was scary; at other times, it was funny as hell. Usually, if you survive the former, it turns into the latter.

We are proud to announce an opportunity to follow a dream and apply for a flight training scholarship which targets students ages 15-19 here in the local Central Pennsylvania and Northern Maryland areas. Awards are available in the following categories and amounts:

Private pilot training Age 16-19 — \$10,000

Sport pilot training Age 16-19 — \$7,500

Glider training Age 15-19 — \$5,000

The scholarship program is supported by the Ray Foundation managed by EAA, and administered by the EAA Chapter network. Initially interested students are nominated, will complete a written application with references, will be interviewed with parents present, and the selection of the nominee will be completed and announced by a #1041 membership committee. The selected student will then apply to EAA Headquarters who will make the final decision and the one year aviation training program will begin.

This takes an exceptional student who demonstrates an internal motivation for flight, meets scholar requirements, is comfortable with and will participate in chapter activities at the airport, and may already have some aviation training and Young Eagle flights.

ATTENTION PROSPECTIVE #1041 MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE: We need your commitment to recommend interested students NOW, and to serve on the committee to evaluate the student's application, personally interview the student and his/her parents, and possibly serve as a mentor throughout the year long process. 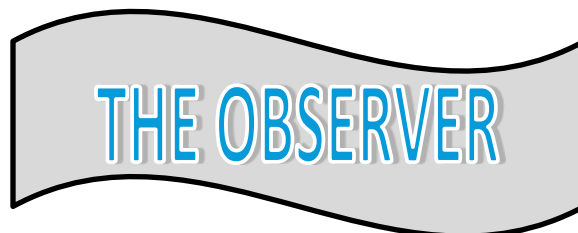

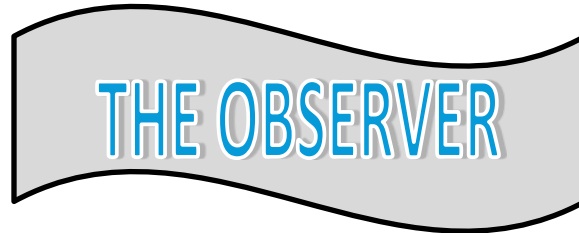

AOPA STEM NEWS

Superintendent Ioannidis and Principal Dietrich,

I hope you recall our meeting at the Pittsburgh Institute of Aeronautics-Hagerstown Maryland branch campus in December of 2019 as we discussed Spring Grove's aviation initiative for high school students and toured PIA. I want to request your assistance with the following initiative.

Piedmont Airlines, a wholly owned subsidiary of American Airlines, has started a Tuition Payment Program for Aviation Maintenance (see press coverage link). <https://www.aviationpros.com/education-training/a&p-ia-training/press-release/21253014/pittsburgh-institute-of-aeronautics-piedmont-airlines-and-pia-launch-new-tuition-program-to-boost-student-access-to-crucial-job-field>

This is exciting news for high school graduates pursuing or considering a career in aviation maintenance or the skilled trades. Piedmont Tuition Payment Program covers full tuition, tools and testing fees at PIA's Hagerstown Maryland or Myrtle Beach South Carolina campus. Any interested student must interview at one of Piedmont's bases to be accepted in one of the open spots. Once accepted, the student makes a commitment to work at Piedmont for 2 years after graduating from PIA. I have attached additional information from Piedmont.

Due to the critical aviation technician shortage, I am reaching out to see if there is an opportunity for PIA and Piedmont to make high school classroom presentations to seniors at Spring Grove. Or, if you and your staff are interested, we can plan a faculty/student field trip to the Harrisburg International Airport Piedmont facility to learn more of this one of a kind program in the aviation industry. The Piedmont staff in Harrisburg is committed to recruit local students to pursue an aviation education and return to Harrisburg to work at Piedmont.

I look forward to your feedback, ideas and suggestions on how students in your district can take advantage of this unique opportunity to pursue an aviation education.

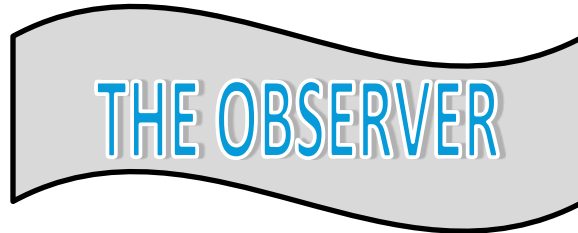

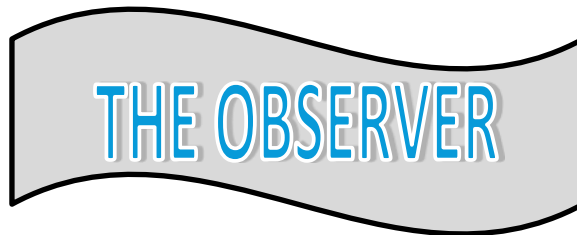
