The May program will be a report from Sun-N-Fun by the Richardson family






Hayden Clark shadowed the maintenance team at Helicopter Applicators last week. Haden hopes to pursue a career as an A&P.



Due to Sun-N-Fun there will be **NO** April IMC/VMC gathering




