

MEMBERSHIP REPORT – 2019 vs 2020 vs 2021 – as of midnight Dec 31, 2020

a) 2019 members who had renewed for 2020:

We had projected a conservative 50% of those not yet renewed by Jan 1 would renew. That was an estimate of 25 members out of 50 would renew – and did.

That estimate was dead on in that we did lose exactly 25 members from 2019, including 2 who moved to Florida and the UK.

Three additional members dropped out, but then rejoined late in 2020.

b) New members in 2020:

This was way off – and very surprising – to the upside!

Looking back at the 10 prior years and skipping two years (high due to hosting the B-17), **we get an average of 15-16 new members each year.**

This year ... more than double that: **40 NEW MEMBERS !!! Probably a single-year record!**

c) Final count on Dec 31, 2020: **195 members**

2 Lifetime members passed away in 2020 and therefore, are not in the final 2020 count.
Ed Dokus (past President) and **Dean Edmonds** (long-time donor) **joined in the 1960's.**

Net change: We lost 25 members from 2019 and 2 more who passed away in 2020. With 40 new members in 2020, that's **a net gain of 13 more members at the end of 2020** than at the end of 2019.

d) Early renewal for 2021: (ended at midnight 12/31/20)

A majority of those many who joined in 2020 also renewed at the time of joining for 2021.

We currently have **195 members** broken down as follows:

Automatic: **10** LIFE members

Renewed: **25** Family members – 11 of these are **new** members

Note: The above 25 are part of 13 families, of which **4 are new families** and two members expanded to add their spouse as a new member!

Renewed: **28** additional **new** members

Renewed: **3** **prior** members **rejoined** in late 2020

Renewed: **95** members from 2019 and before

Check on the way: **2** members

Not yet: **1** **new** (in 2020) members

Not yet: **24** other 2020 members

Dropping out: **3** members have said they are dropping out effective Jan 1, 2021

(2 were parents of a youth and David is now an adult paying member; one sold his plane and dropped out of EAA, but still plans to make a donation to EAA106!)

Final status of the 195 members on 12/31/2020:

10 Lifetime members

155 Renewed That's an **84% of non-life members renewed** (vs **67%** on 12/31/2019)

27 Not yet renewed

3 will be dropping out 1/1/21
