Application for this years Ray Aviation Scholarships has been approved!

This year we were very successful in soliciting donations and we qualified for TWO Ray Aviation Scholarships! Each scholarship covers all expenses for the student up to \$12,000 towards a private pilot certificate. Charlie MacInnis and AI Sturza have volunteered to be the scholarship coordinators. Their help is much appreciated on behalf of the entire chapter. One scholarship has already been awarded (see below) and the applications for the second scholarship are in the process of being collected.

Kael Yothers, 18, of Harbor Springs is the winner of the chapter's \$12,000 Ray Aviation Scholarship for 2025. Kael has been taking lessons from Al Sturza and is expected to solo soon. She has signed the required EAA waiver that finalizes the process needed to allow her to receive scholarship funds. Charlie MacInnis will serve as her mentor to document her progress. He has loaned her a pair of Lightspeed headphones to make sure she can hear Al's good instruction in the air. Kael has been a regular at our Saturday pilot breakfasts and was joined by her mother at last Saturday's get-together. Kael currently works at Meyer Hardware in Harbor Springs. She and her parents are members of the Cowboy Fast Draw Association and, in the last couple of years, have all won shooting competitions throughout the country.
