President Sarah Pagano called the meeting to order at 1706 EDT. The Board meeting was held in-person and via Zoom.

Minutes from the 9/16/2021 Board meeting were approved (Ryden/B. Haskett).

Treasurer's report: Assistant Treasurer Fick reported that all accounts are up to date.

account balances as of September 30, 2021:

Fancy Bird House LLC:	\$6,221.50
EAA Chapter 1093:	\$8,134.02
Clubhouse LLC:	\$ 853.93

\$10,000 check from Edward Jones (Chapter investment account) received, will be deposited 10/22 in FBH account.

Financial institution will be changed to Members First Credit Union following the November vote for the new Board of Directors; three separate accounts will be established. MFCU will need a copy of the by-laws and a letter with a copy of the Board resolution authorizing the change; the Board can vote on a resolution via e-mail after the November membership meeting.

Membership Committee: Chair Ryden reported that current membership stands at 98 members with addition of two new members.

Hangar Committee: S. Pagano reported that EAA Annex door was repaired by Mid Michigan Garage Door this date. All hangar rents are current, most leases have been renewed.

Young Eagles: No YE flights on October 9 due to weather conditions.

Scholarship Committee: EAA has approved Jason Labby to be the Chapter's second 2021 Ray Scholarship recipient.

Nominating Committee: Survey Monkey will be sent 10/23 to solicit votes for the Board of Directors, responses due by noon on November 6.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Cessna 150A disposition: McPeak reported that FAA registration is pending. Suggestion that pile of parts be valued as-is for possible future tax audit.

RV-12 build project: Sipp reported that half of the horizontal stabilizer has been riveted, video will be posted on group Facebook page. S. Haskett will re-post video on Chapter 1093 Facebook page.

Motion (Tom Ryden/Dick Sipp) to authorize the Chair of the Investment Committee to withdraw \$10,000 from the Chapter's account with Edward Jones to be used to pay for the next RV-12 kit (wings) was passed via e-mail votes of Board members on October 6.

Great Lakes Bay Invitational fundraiser: Ryden reported that determination of final distribution to Chapter 1093 is expected in early November.

EAA's Eagle Flights: S. Pagano reported that 11/13 Eagle Flights for veterans has eleven veterans signed-up to date, limit of thirty veterans allowed. Bill Eyre was flown during past week, article in Midland Daily News.

EAA Building maintenance: B. Haskett reported that painting work bee will be scheduled.

Aviation Camp/YE Workshop: S. Pagano reported that Workshop would be scheduled for a date in February, 2022, for ten participants. Planning has begun for next summer's Aviation Camp 2022.

Aviation Career Day: S. Pagano reported that event was a success; vendors want to return and 60+ attendees appreciated the opportunity to meet representatives of various aviation related disciplines. Next event will be in spring 2022, or November, 2022.

Rusty Pilot Seminar: S. Pagano reported that AOPA will present seminar on May 21, 2022, using Chapter classroom facility.

Investment Committee: S. Pagano reported that the appointment of a replacement member is pending

'Flight Night': MPS will sponsor a Flight Night in spring, 2022, for Plymouth School students. This will not be an EAA 1093 event, but the Chapter may donate dollars or volunteers.

NEW BUSINESS:

Volunteer Thank You Party, holiday party: S. Pagano proposed that the Chapter have a party to recognize/thank Chapter volunteers. Motion (McPeak/Ryden) that Chapter host a partially catered (Chapter to provide the main course, participants to bring potluck dishes) holiday party for all Chapter members (and guests) and recognize/thank the Chapter volunteers during the event; motion passed.

1050C: Hangar Committee requested that Cessna N1050C vacate hangar 7A1 and be moved to the Yonkers Hangar. No rent would be charged for use of the Yonkers Hangar, and hangar 7A1 would be available to rent. The request was approved by consensus of the Board.

Public comment: Former Camper Kris Anderson has been hired by United to pilot an Airbus or a Dreamliner, another success story for the Chapter 1093 educational efforts.

President Pagano adjourned the meeting at 1822 EDT.
