Minutes from the 8/19/2021 Board meeting were approved (Gallant/Ryden).

Treasurer's report: Treasurer Marks and Assistant Treasurer Fick reported that all accounts are up to date.

account balances as of August 31, 2021:

Pancake breakfast expenses and scholarship disbursements were expenditures for the month over and above the usual utilities, etc. EAA National transferred \$4,000 for the Ray Scholarship program.

Membership Committee: Chair Ryden reported that current membership stands at 95 members with addition of three new members.

- Hangar Committee: S. Pagano reported that EAA Annex door repair is pending. Material for FBH lower door seals will be ordered, Chapter members will install.
- One hangar is currently unoccupied, potential lessors have been contacted.
- Young Eagles: Chair Gallant reported there were no YE flights on September 11 since that was the day of the Chapter's pancake breakfast.
- Scholarship Committee: Chair Murphy reported that Ray Scholarship recipient Toby Pobanz has begun flying. Another name has been submitted to the EAA for approval to be the Chapter's second 2021 Ray Scholarship recipient.

A Chapter scholarship was awarded to Arian Perez in the amount of \$2,000.

Cessna 150A disposition: McPeak reported the FAA registration form was corrected and has been re-submitted.

RV-12 build project: S. Pagano/Sipp reported that build sessions are on Wednesdays and Saturdays, schedule is available on group's Facebook page and builders can sign up via signupgenius. To date, rudder and stabilizer have been built; work continues.

Great Lakes Bay Invitational fundraiser: Ryden reported that Chapter 1093 will receive at least \$4,500 for our participation, final amount TBD.
