The Wednesday night regulars, minus Galen, attended. This was another session spent almost entirely on deburring the 56 rib segments that were previously modified for specific wing stations. This is probably the most tedious deburring task in the entire project due to the volume and complexity of the edge volume. To take a break near the end of the session some minor assembly of detailed parts was completed. The team is making great progress in interpreting the plans with little or no help.

September 14th

The Wednesday night crew met again this evening. We were glad to welcome our additional mentor, Dr. Brian Perry, along with Dave Schmelzer. John Mcpeake, Galen Sape, and Tom Tolton rounded out the crew. After nearly two sessions spent deburring and prepping the main ribs the crew was glad to be able to assemble them to both main wing spars. A fun night!



September 21st

The regular Wednesday night crew was in attendance in force tonight and clicking on all 4 (Rotax) cylinders. Mike Engseth, Tom Tolton, Chris Pagano, Galen Sape, and John Mcpeak. Dave Schmelzer and Sipp mentored. The wing rear spars were deburred and assembled and then fitted and riveted to the wing assembles. The wings are taking shape nicely, feel free to come and visit.



September 28th

The ever-loyal Wednesday night crew was in force again this evening; Mike Engesath Tom Tolton, Chris Pagano, John D. McPeak, Sarah Haskett joined us later. The usual mentors included Dave Schmelzer and Dick Sipp. Joe Maj also joined us later in the evening as well to check on our progress. After mocking up the nose rib positions, all 28 were riveted in place. This nearly completes the wing framework.
