Last Months Ercoupe Presentation:

Last month Lawson Laslo joined us to share his experiences restoring a 1946 Ercoupe. Lawson started watching airplanes when he was ten or eleven years old. Like the rest of us he was hooked. A Ray Aviation scholarship award winner Lawson soloed at sixteen. He has some Cherokee time in addition to the Ercoupe time. Lawson has taken upset training and earned his tail-wheel endorsement. Currently he is working on his instrument rating with the near term goal of becoming an instructor. He has a long term goal of flying the F-16 for the National Guard.

The Ercoupe, “War Bug”, was located in 2019 and took 5 months to restore. It came with an O-200 engine. He said there were some issues along the way. The pictures speak for themselves on all of the hard work put into this aircraft.
