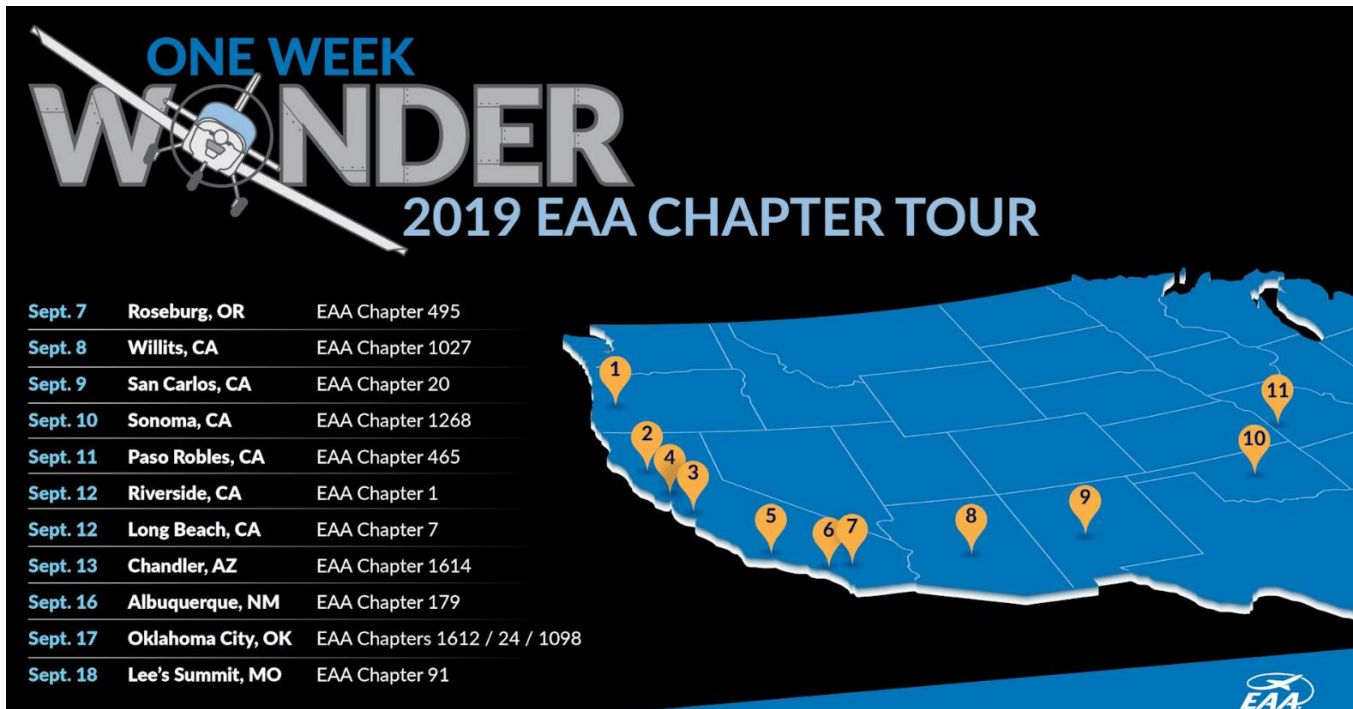

## EAA ONE-WEEK WONDER

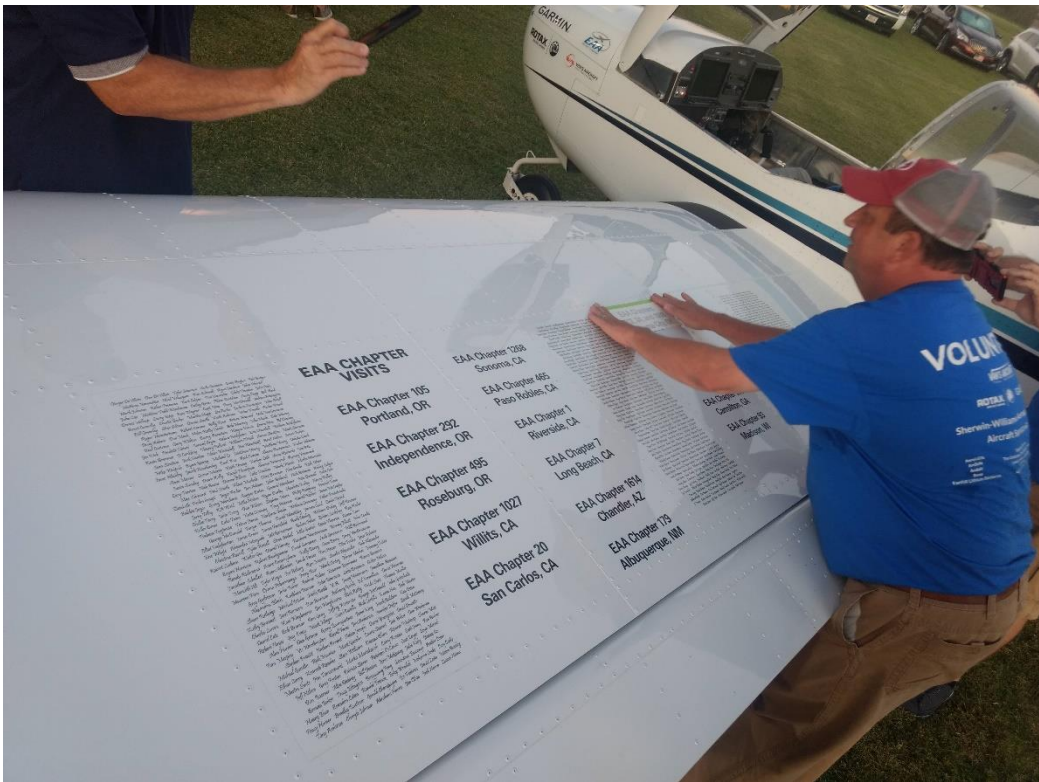

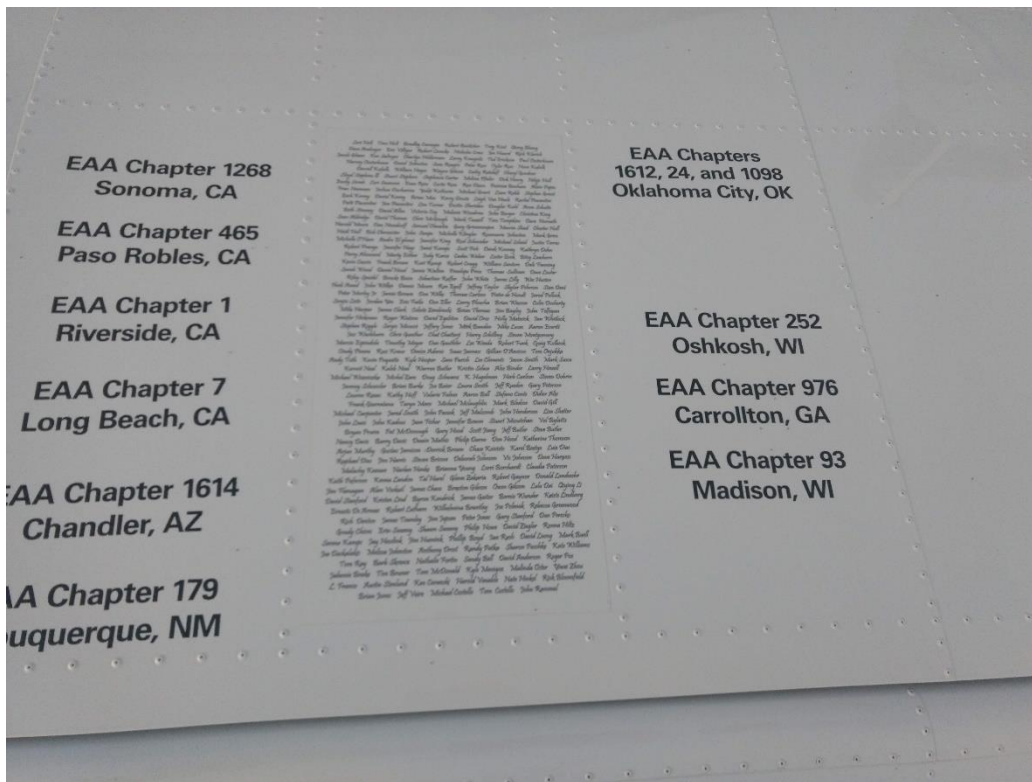
