During the flight, answer landmark questions on a questionnaire.
End the flight with a spot landing at Sundance. Easy & Fun!
(Use your GPS, Ipad, or whatever you chose, to navigate)

Having a navigator to help with cockpit workload is the **safest** option, but you can fly solo.
Route is about 100 nautical miles and takes approximately one hour.

Arrive: 8:00am - 9:00am
Briefing: 9:15am
Flights Start: 10:45am
Lunch: 1:00pm
Awards: After Lunch

You will need something to write with and a time piece such as a watch or phone.
This is a fun and easy event. We will tell you exactly what you need to do.
