Fifth-graders take airplane for 120-mile joy-ride

Tuesday, 18 May 1948 • Oklahoma City, Oklahoma

The ERCO Ercoupe 415 (*right*) was advertised as "the world's safest airplane" and "nearly foolproof." With no rudder pedals, it certainly was far simpler to fly than most other aircraft, a fact that was demonstrated all too clearly when two preteen boys stole one and took it for a joy-ride.

On Monday, 11-year-old Jimmy Bodard and 12-year-old Robert Ronald Peterson cut school to hang out at Downtown Airpark, where they spent



the night sleeping in a hangered Cessna. While their parents reported them missing on Tuesday, they continued to play hooky. Then, at five o'clock that afternoon, they pushed an Ercoupe from its hanger. Oklahoma, but when Bodard went to depart, he hit a furrow and the undercarriage

buckled. The boys stole a horse and rode toward town. After turning their mount loose,

they were picked up by the sheriff. Their story attributed their presence 120 miles from home to thumbing rides in cars. But when the Ercoupe was discovered on Thursday,

authorities put two-and-two together. Confronted, the boys confessed to their escapade.
