Welcome to the April Edition


Welcome to the May Edition of Permian Wing!


Join Us for Our First-Ever Aviation Poker Run Fundraiser!



Thank you for helping to make EAA Chapter 123 a place where aviation dreams take flight. We're proud to have such an incredible team of volunteers!



Final Flight Notes

Springtime Safety Essentials



As spring gives way to early summer, it's a perfect time to fine-tune our flying habits and mindset. Whether you're logging more flight hours, brushing off some winter rust, or simply enjoying beautiful skies, here are a few reminders to keep you sharp and ready:

Weather Awareness: Stay Flexible
May often brings fast-changing weather—pop-up showers,
building thermals, and gusty winds. Always double-check
your preflight weather briefing and have an alternate plan in
your back pocket.

Flight Reviews and Refreshers
Spring and summer flying seasons are busy! If your biennial
flight review is coming up, or if you haven't flown much
lately, consider scheduling a refresher flight with a CFI. It's a
great confidence booster and keeps skills sharp.

Fuel Planning: No Shortcuts
Longer daylight hours can tempt us to stretch a flight a little too far. Stick to solid fuel planning habits—verify quantities before every flight, plan alternates, and land with healthy reserves.

Traffic! Traffic!

More pilots mean more mid-air traffic—especially near non-towered airports. Keep your head on a swivel, broadcast your position clearly, and assume others might not be looking or communicating perfectly.

X Stay Involved, Stay Inspired Whether it's attending a gathering, helping at a Young Eagles event, or sharing project updates, staying active with our aviation community keeps the passion alive—and makes us all better pilots and builders.


