John reminded everyone if there are members that are interested in organizing Fly-outs, that they are more than welcome to do so. He noted that this is not a long-term commitment, but rather a sporadic initiative.

During Bootcamp that took place on Feb 01 2020 in Lakeland, the officers learned a lot of interesting things about EAA and the roll of the chapters. One of those things is that when a chapter is interested in buying tools, the EAA will subsidized 30% of the cost up to \$300.
