Bio of Ray Brown

We are saddened to have to report the passing of long time Swifter Ray Brown .

Ray passed away on 29 December 2018 .

Ray was a U.S. Navy Veteran , a Law Enforcement Officer , a real estate broker , and aircraft relocation team member .

In addition to being a member of the Swift Foundation , and previous board member , Ray was a Lifetime member of the EAA , NRA , member of the Quiet Birdman , and AOPA .

Ray and his wife Judy were established member residents of Loves Landing Aviation Community (97FL) in central Florida .

Ray owned his Swift NC3756K for over 43 years , and was widely recognized as the resident expert on all subjects related to our Swift aircraft , configuration , Modifications , Parts and Service of our prized aircraft .

In addition to being a pilot and owner of Swift aircraft , Ray was also an FAA Licensed A&P and IA . As well as holder of multiple STC's for Swift aircraft .

Over the years , Ray has been deeply involved in the restoration , modifications of numerous Swift project aircraft .

Ray also owned one of the largest collections of Swift parts known to exist .

Ray's Adept Influence within our Swift Community will be sorely missed .

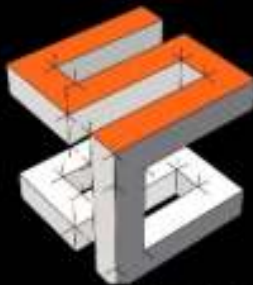
