Minutes of Chapter meeting held on 3/25/2023

The meeting commenced at 10:00am in the presence of members and guests.

Peter reported that we currently have 8 pilots and 25 children scheduled for our Young Eagles Rally to be held on 4/15/2023. Ground volunteers are asked to be there for setup at 7:00am and the children will begin arriving at 8:30am.
