Bearhawk Build - to - Alaska

- ▶ Mark is an aeronautical engineer with degrees from Worcester Polytechnic Institute, the University of Maryland, and MIT.
- ▶ He retired from Sikorsky aircraft in early 2020 and now works as a contract engineer for the Army.
- ▶ His certifications and flight experience includes; Private pilot license SEL, SES. Additional training includes, complex aircraft, high performance aircraft, spin, tail wheel, and aerobatics, He has 20 hours of helicopter flight time and a solo endorsement.
- ▶ He completed construction of his Bearhawk in 2014 and is a half owner of an RV-7A.
- ▶ He was the Vice President & President of Silver City Flying Club (1990-91), and is the current President EAA Chapter 27, Meriden CT.
- ▶ Mark initiated the "Teens to Flight" program where high school kids built an RV-12 under the mentorship of chapter members. The aircraft flew in May 2020 and is now used as a club aircraft separate from the chapter.
