
October News & Views

Airport News from Ryan:

- * State and local building permits for the new King Air hangar have been issued and construction is just getting started.
- * The current T-hangar rehabilitation project is in full swing with several hangars ready for new concrete floors to be poured as soon as the weather allows.
- * As most are aware, the North Vernon Municipal Airport has received the Airport of The Year Award for 2023 from Aviation Indiana, including a \$1000 incentive to be used at the discretion of the airport administration. This is the only airport to receive this award for a second time, having also received the Award in 2012.

In the airport's application package for the award, EAA Chapter 1328 was cited as a major asset and contributor to local aviation education efforts. Bryan Swank accepted the donation on behalf of the chapter during a recent session of the North Vernon City Council. Representatives from Aviation Indiana, along with city and airport officials, were in attendance. Congratulations to all involved!
