


Kit: Sonex Waiex

NAVIGATION BY SOUND?

Take the next ten minutes and watch this very informative video on how pilots navigated during the 1940's using nothing but a low frequency radio receiver, their ears, and a chart. Developed around 1928, this was state of the art navigation in it's prime using just two letters broadcast in Morse code (a DIT and DAH sound). Today we have it made with glass panels and lots of navigational accessories to help us get from one place to another. Put yourself in the pilot's seat and view the ride to see what it was like to "hear" your way across America.


Chapter Member Name Tags
