

An exciting day at Kirkwall airport

The Fresson Trust marked the 90th anniversary of Captain Fresson's pioneering of the first internal Air Mail service in the UK, in collaboration with Highlands and Islands Airports Limited. The Trust hosted the **only remaining airworthy de Havilland Dragon** which belonged to Highland Airways.

On 29th May 1934 Captain Fresson set off from Longman Aerodrome in Inverness bound for Orkney with the Royal Mail. Today, his faithful Dragon G-

ACET re-enacted the route, leaving Inverness Airport at about 10:30, bound for Kirkwall. It departed with the chase aircraft via the City of Inverness, overflying Longman Aerodrome from where Captain Fresson set off 90 years ago. Routing north, it overflew Wick, and then pressed onward to Kirkwall, arriving there at lunch time. (Regrettably, Wick Airport is not open for arrivals on Saturday, so a visit there could not be made.)

The flight was delayed a couple of days beyond the actual anniversary, due to the weather. (Whilst the Trust recognizes from history that weather did not stop Captain Fresson in his day, 90 years on greater care is to be taken of his aeroplane and so the day of the flight was only decided at the last minute.)

I was very happy to be asked to attend at Kirkwall, on behalf of the Orkney Aviation Festival, and to be able to be part of this fascinating occasion, and to take some photos and video.
