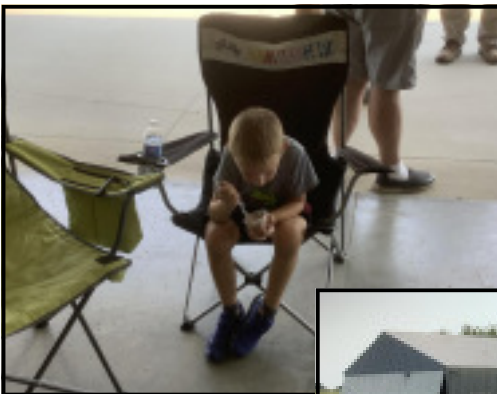

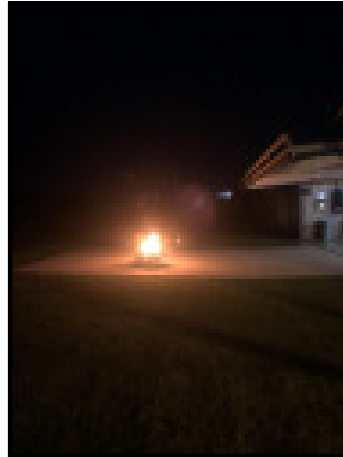
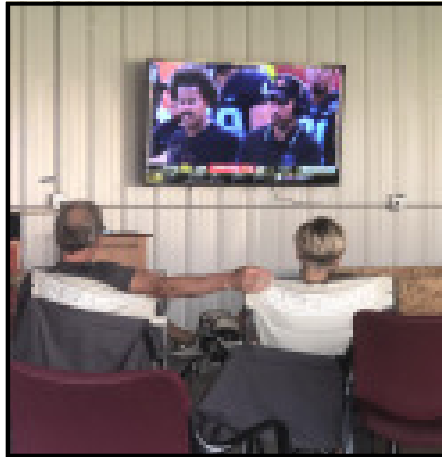
President's Ramblings October 2021

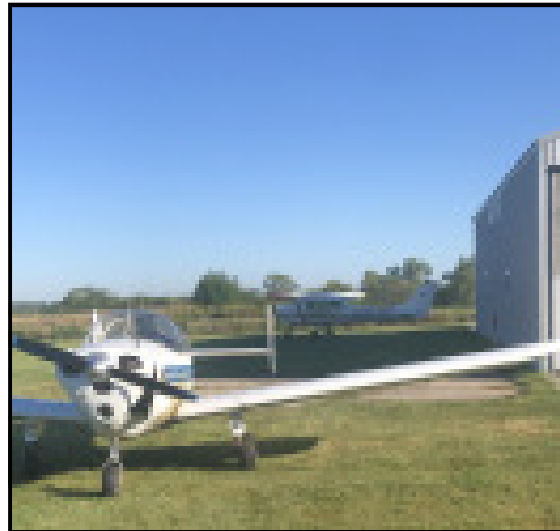
