Information on South Sioux City Airport Museum

Please see the information below regarding the KSUX museum, catering, and FBO. We will need a rough head count for the museum and obviously catering. Please feel free to share with everyone.

Museum

Admission is \$10 for adults, \$8 for seniors 55+ and veterans, \$5 for kids.

The museum is 30,000 sqft and they have a location somewhat in the center of the museum for seating. They have table and chairs that fit 6-8 at each table. There is no charge for any of that other than admission but they do request that they are allotted time for a presentation that is roughly 30 minutes to 1 hour depending on what we are looking for.

FBO:

No facility fee for the day. If there is overnight parking it is \$20-\$30 depending on the plane.

100LL is currently \$7.34 obviously subject to change.

There is 1 crew car available but the museum is only a 5 minute walk from the FBO.

Catering:

They have quite the menu, but for ease and price I got the price for a BBQ Lunch plate which comes with 2 sides and is \$11.75. There is also a 2 piece fried chicken lunch with 1 side \$7.95 or 2 sides \$9.95.
