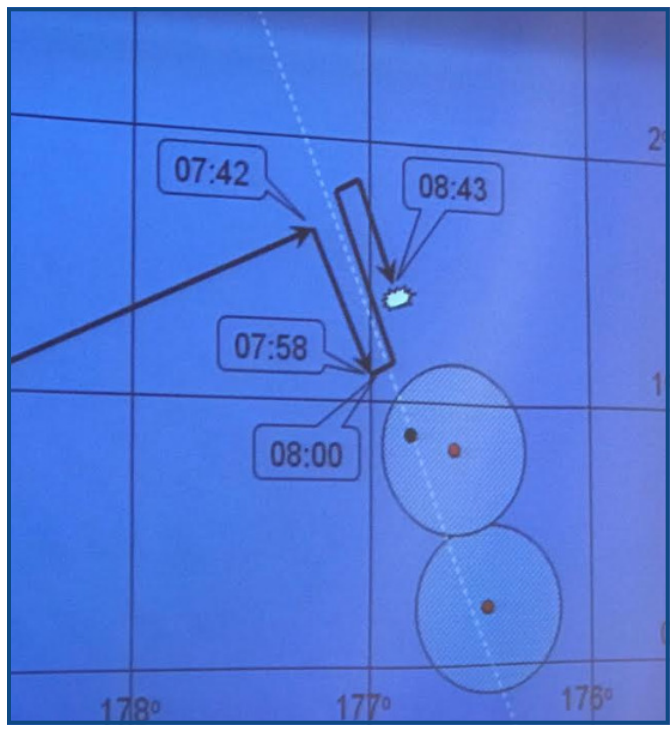
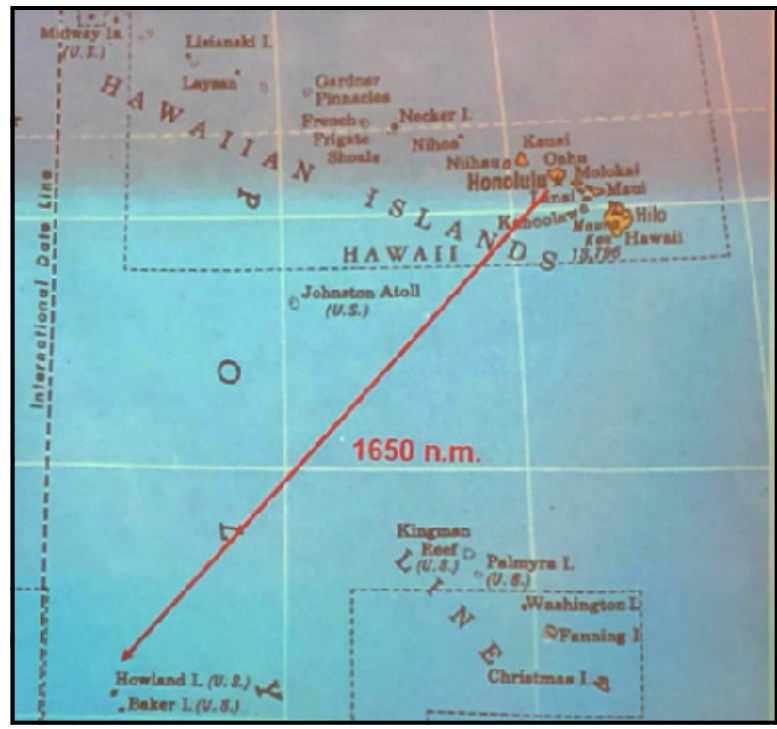
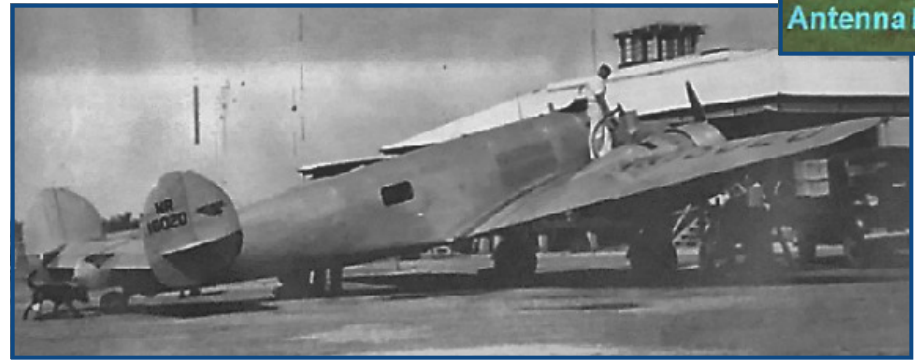


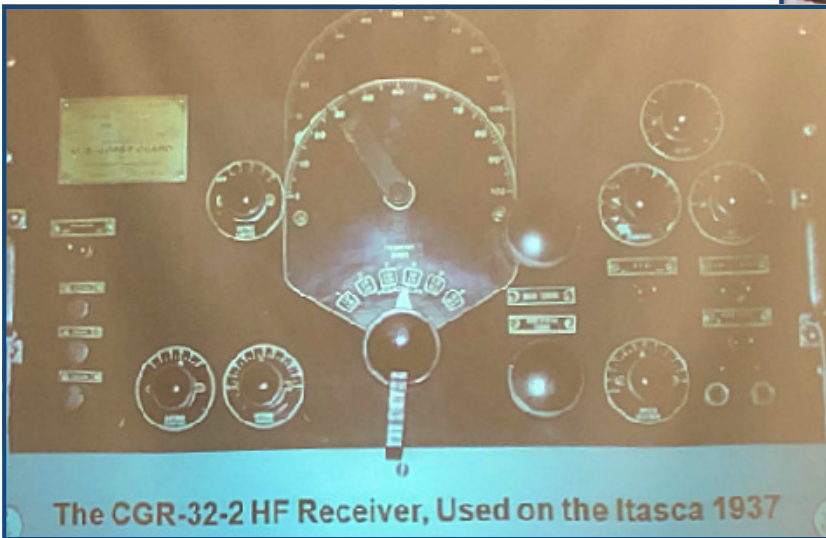
Computer Model Analysis of the Antenna

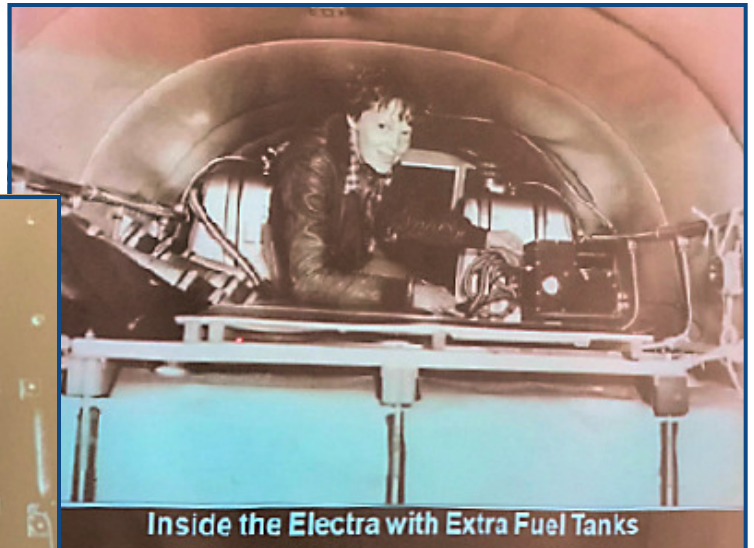


Antenna Range Measurements of the 1/12 Scale Electra L10E





The CGR-32-2 HF Receiver, Used on the Itasca 1937



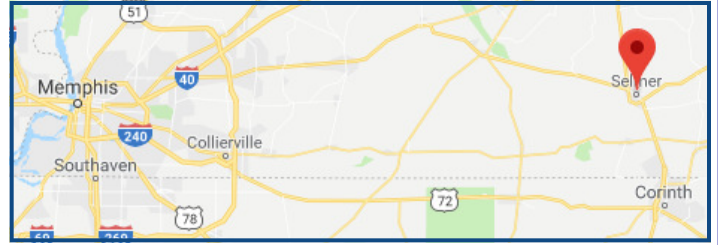
Inside the Electra with Extra Fuel Tanks

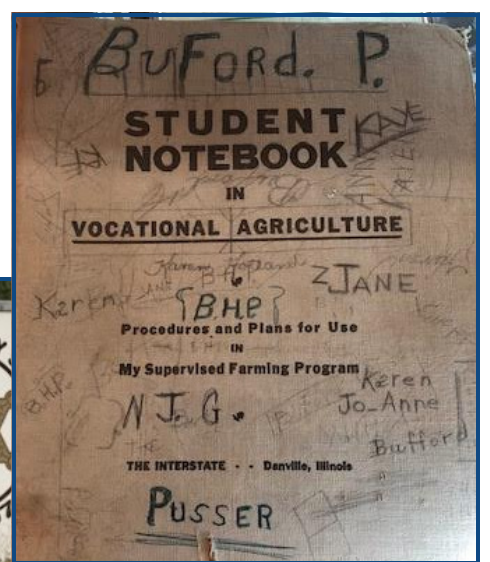
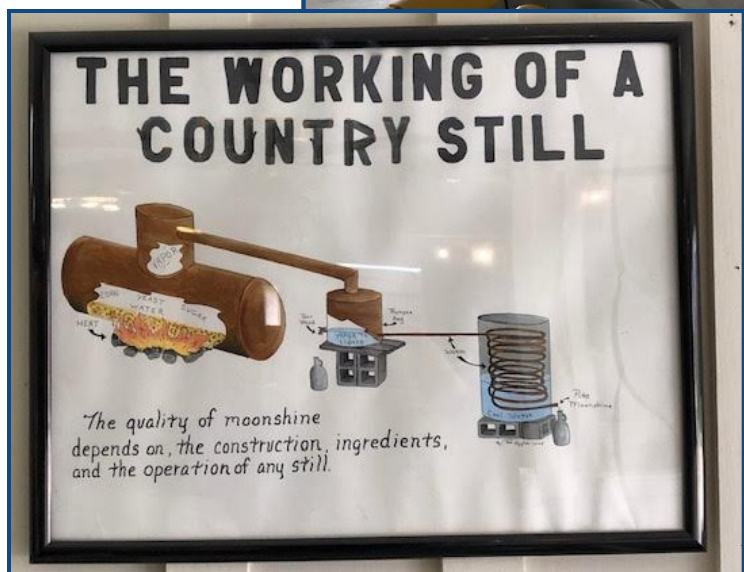
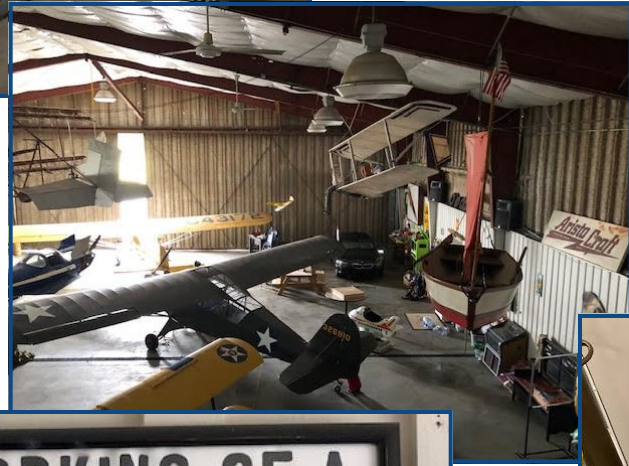
